MILANO, JULY 5–6, 2016

At the occasion of the ICOM Milano 2016 Conference, The International Association of History Museums is organising a visit and discussion for museum professionals to the **Museo del Risorgimento – Palazzo Moriggia, Via Borgonuovo 23, Milano**. All IAMH members are invited to participate.

This visit is in continuation of the very successful previous such visits by our Association to: *House of Terror Museum* (Budapest 2005), *Museu d'Historia de Catalunya* (Barcelona 2007), *Musée International de la Réforme* (Geneva 2008), *STAM City Museum* (Ghent 2009), *Musée Gadagne* (Lyon 2010), *Historisches Museum* (Luzern 2011), *Historisches Museum* (Basel 2012), *Museum aan de Stroom* (Antwerp 2014) and *National Historical Museum* (Athens 2015).



- **The Museo del Risorgimento** is dedicated to a specific period of Italian History, which led to the creation of an united nation in 1861 and the annexation of Rome in 1870.
- **Founded in 1885**, the Museum set up in the palazzo Moriggia – an 18th Century palace – in 1951. It has been restored in 2011 for the 150th anniversary of the Italian Unity. The Museum is under the authority of the Milanese Head of Culture, and is part of the “Civiche Raccolte Storiche”. It is also the home of the Historical Institute, which conserves important archives on Risorgimento as well as World War I and II.

- **The permanent exhibition** presents the story of Italy from the first Napoleonic campaign (1796) to the annexation of Rome.

The ordinary annual General Assembly of the IAMH will be held on the afternoon after our visit, on July 6, at ICOM Conference venue at Milan Congressi – MiCo.

We present our gratitude to the Museo del Risorgimento for inviting us and for organising the event in cooperation with the Association.
